Who should attend?

If you are concerned that a loved one is at risk for overdosing on heroin or a prescription pain medication, this training is for you.

What will you learn?

Training participants will learn:

- Opioid types
- How to recognize, respond to, and prevent an opioid overdose
- How to administer intra-nasal naloxone to reverse an overdose

What is Naloxone?

It is a prescription medication that reverses an opioid overdose. It cannot be used to get high and it is not addictive.

What will I get for completing this training?

You will receive a certification valid for two years, a prescription for naloxone, an overdose prevention kit, and all other supplies necessary to intervene in the event of an overdose.
